



Guide to Locate Your Tire DOT Codes

A complete DOT code will be 10-12 letters and numbers and end in four numbers. The following letters are not used in DOT codes: G, I, O, Q, S, and Z.



Example DOT code for a tire made in 2011

If you do not see the letters DOT or only see 4-6 letters and/or numbers, the complete DOT code is on the opposite side of the tire. Many tire manufacturers only put the full DOT code on one side of the tire, with a partial code on the other side.
